Madison Ave. Pedestrian Bridge Butterfly Project



Last fall during Good Neighbor Weekend, one of our projects was clearing brush and trash from the Madison Avenue pedestrian bridge and the sidewalk leading to School 31. Meanwhile, the Old Southside Neighborhood cleared out the brush on their side of the walkway.

This spring, Allies Indianapolis, a partnership between Indianapolis Neighborhood Resource Center (INRC) and Public Allies, painted the bridge and received a permit from the City for a butterfly garden made out of aluminum cans. Working with an art class from Manual High School, the butterflies were created. Then, on Friday, May 13 both groups hung the butterflies on the bridge. If you get a chance, go and check it out. The bridge can be accessed by going to the end of Lincoln Street by School 31 and heading north on the walk that runs parallel to Madison Avenue.
