This event is a great fundraiser for the neighborhood and it's always a lot of fun, so we hope you can make it!


House Signs Finally Available

- Lastly, offer your time and efforts. Charity and cause-based groups often need people to donate their time.


Bates-Hendricks Neighborhood is no different in any of these needs, and we'd love to have you join us or help us in any way you can!
