Did you know that the first Hook's Drug Store was located at 1101 S. East Street in Bates-Hendricks? In partnership with our local historian, the Bates-Hendricks Neighborhood Association (BHNA) is working to fundraise the needed \$3,000 to fund a marker through the Indiana Historical Bureau.
