
Neighborhood Beautification Updates

Last month, the neighborhood's Beautification Committee hosted two different neighborhood cleanups. The first cleanup was on the S. New Jersey Street Esplanade and was the focus area of August's 2nd Saturday cleanup. A bad storm had recently hit the neighborhood and caused a large tree to fall on the north end of the Esplanade. Several neighbors managed to clear out all tree limbs, leaves, and dead plants.

The second beautification event last month was the Great Indy Cleanup on August 26. Over a dozen neighbors met at East Street and Orange Street and got started with clearing street gutters and cleaning up litter and heavy trash in the Northwest and Northeast regions of the neighborhood. Keep Indianapolis Beautiful donated a packer truck to help dispose of multiple mattresses, furniture, and yard waste from




Bates-Hendricks Neighborhood Association
