He served neighborhood interests in other ways over the years, such as coaching the Bates-Hendricks team in the Indy Recreational Youth Baseball (RBI) league, volunteering on the board of Southeast Neighborhood Development (SEND), and co-leading an environmental science club at SENSE Charter School.




Bates-Hendricks Neighborhood Association
